5. **(As a preparation for this study, please read Genesis 37-50 in order to be able to summarize this story)**
Read and Discuss **Genesis 37:5-17**
 - a. Why do you think Joseph’s brothers hated his dream?
 - b. Do you still have a dream for leaving a legacy in your life?
 - c. Has your dream been encouraged, or discouraged, by family and friends?

The Nightmare

6. Joseph’s dream caused his brothers to hate him, throw him in a well and sell him into slavery at the age of 17. Later, Joseph was falsely accused of a crime that he did not commit and landed in prison. It seemed like Joseph’s dream had turned into a nightmare. It seems like his legacy was lost. **(Read Genesis chapters 37-39)**
 - a. Has your life legacy dream turned into a nightmare?
 - b. **Read Genesis 39:21**
 - i. How did Joseph trust God with his life legacy, even when he was in prison?
 - ii. How can you trust God with your life legacy, in the middle of a nightmare?

A New Day

7. It took Joseph 13 years to see his life legacy and dream become a reality. **(Read Genesis 41:46)**
 - a. What role did trust play in Joseph’s journey from a life legacy dream, a suffocating nightmare, and the hope of a new day and the fulfillment of his dream? **(Read Genesis 50:20)**
 - b. How does this story encourage you to trust God more?
 - c. What commitments do you sense God is asking you to make, in order to leave a legacy built upon trust in Him?
