



Grow Guide #Winning Week 2

1. In his message, Dan uses the term resurgence quite often. A resurgence is similar to a comeback. Comebacks are familiar in sports and life. What is the biggest resurgence or comeback that you have taken part in or are aware of?
2. Read Mark 3:16 and Acts 4:13. In these verses we saw changes in the apostles ranging from before their calling to after Jesus resurrection. They needed resurgence in 3 areas (like we all do). What are those areas?
3. After choosing His apostles and causing major comebacks in their lives, Jesus focuses on the rest of us. Read Mark 4:30-32, Isaiah 40:18, Ezekiel 17:23 and 31:6 and Daniel 4:12 and 21. Jesus recognized that the world needed a comeback, so He mentioned how the Kingdom of God (His kingdom) could provide that. What seed was His kingdom compared to? Why?
4. A mustard seed is small and unassuming, about the size of a puffy sesame seed. There is nothing noticeably special about it. Yet it can grow into a huge tree where birds and animals nest, live and find shelter. How is the Kingdom of God like that?
5. Dan made a point that the parable of the mustard seed shows a resurgence of what over doubt? What 3 questions, concerning faith, do we need to ask ourselves?
6. Read Mark 4:35-41 and Daniel 7:2-3. Living in this world we face evil on a daily basis. What 2 questions do we need to answer concerning evil and its effects?
7. Read Mark 8:36. What do you need a resurgence or comeback from? Do you have the reality of the biggest and most important resurgence in history in your life? If not, what 5 steps do you need to take.
